Usage:

AMPLifier is a powerful Audio MPEG Player using a modern graphical Userinterface (GUI) done for Amiga. AMPLifier may be used together with mpega.library by Stephan Tavenard to do software based decoding of MPEG-Audio. The other possibility is to take the more powerful hardware solution like f.e. Melody-Z2, Peggy+ or the new Melody1200PRO/Plus. AMPLifier is Shareware but is working without limitations.

Some features listed:

- supports playback of MPEG Audio up to MPEG 2.5 Layer III and even AIFF, MAUD, WAVE und RAW titles
- basic functionality was done as known from generic CD-Players (play, pause, stop, forward, backward, skip back, skip forward)
- graphical effects via Plug-In modules
- optimised Buffering for software decoding
- audio output via Xaudio.device or AHI
- sizeable, scalable und configurable BOOPS based GUI or alternative:
 - WinAMP skins giving different graphical designs
- opens and moves to a "public screen" any time fully up to users likes
- fast and easy positioning within a song by moving slider only
- powerful playlist (sort, edit, load and save of list)
- random and endless playback
- Drag-and-Drop of files, directories and volumes including recursive scan
- ID3-Tag support for getting detailed infos out of the songs (artist, title, album, ...)
- Time played / elapsed display
- ARexx-Port with tons of powerful commands
- AmigaOS Commodity (iconify etc.)
- much more... !!!
